CHECK LIST FOR RIDE-ON BUGGIES

KNOW THE CONTROLS AND HOW TO USE THEM

1. Ignition switch and immobiliser key
2. Accelerator
3. Footbrake
4. Parking brake – set the brake before leaving the ride-on buggy
5. Reversing control

KNOW YOUR DRIVING CONDITIONS

Ride-on buggies can only be used for the number of occupants it was designed to carry and by those authorised to do so.

Ride-on buggies must not be used on areas of the course where prohibitive signs are placed.

The vehicle must not be driven up and down the course when looking for golf balls.

The vehicle must not be used on tees, greens or slopes leading up to them.

The vehicle must not be within 2 metres of, or on, slopes leading to any bunkers, ditches or ponds (except when crossing designated bridges).

Always consider the terrain, existing vehicular and pedestrian traffic conditions, as well as environmental factors that may affect your ability to operate the vehicle safely.

Drive the vehicle only as fast as the terrain and safety considerations allow.

To avoid tipping over, drive the buggies straight up and down the slopes.

Slow down before corners.

All turns must be executed at reduced speeds.

Avoid sudden stops or changes of direction that may result in loss of control.

PROBLEMS

1. Only cross ditches/stream by use of bridges
2. Do not make unnecessary climbs, such as to the 16th tee
3. Do not take onto 17th tee, take care crossing bridge on 17th
4. Follow paths where available, use direct routes where possible
5. Take care when turning right off railway bridge towards 14th tee
